



A1: Unpacking Your Gloves

Before use, check the battery power by pressing the On/Off button once for each glove. The charge level will be displayed for 3 seconds before moving into operational mode. Refer to the Charge Guide below to evaluate usage time - if insufficient, charge your product.

Three blinking arrows
- 6 Hours** (continuous use)
Three arrows
- 4 Hours** (continuous use)
Two arrows
- 2 Hours** (continuous use)
One arrow
- 1 Hour** (continuous use)

Four lights

A2: Powering Up Your Gloves

Put each glove on and press the (blue) On/Off button once. The glove will power up in the Charge Indicator Mode. After 3 seconds the glove will automatically move into the Signal Operation Mode.

A3: Test Your Gloves

Check to make sure each glove is on by holding your hand upright and looking at the electronics unit. You are now ready to begin using your Signal Gloves.

Section B: Product Use

Remember, there are no switches. The gloves work independently and change color and pattern based only on the user's hand position.

B1: Stop

Either hand in the upright position produces a RED X.

B2: Go

Either hand in any horizontal position produces GREEN chasing arrows.

B3: Off

Either glove held down turns all glove lights OFF.

B4: General Signaling Protocols

Any combination of current hand signals can be achieved using the Signal Gloves.

B5: Turning Off Signal Gloves after Use

When you are finished using your Signal Gloves, press the On/Off button once on each glove. After 5 seconds four corner lights will flash and electronics will be off. Checking the battery power after each use is recommended.

B6: Automatic Turn Off

If any glove is left ON, and in the Signal Mode, it will turn off automatically if there is no movement for 5 minutes.

QUICK START

1. Press On/Off button
2. Wait 3 seconds
product will enter the Signal Mode
3. Begin Using
Up = Stop
Horizontal = Chasing Arrows
Down = Lights Off

Section C : Modes

C1: Signal Mode

This is the default mode operating as described in Section B. To return to this mode from any other mode, point the glove downward and press the On/Off button twice (pause between presses). The product will now be in Signal Mode.

C2: Strobe Mode

The Strobe Mode creates a fast blinking light effect. With the glove turned horizontally to the left, press the On/Off button twice (pause between presses). The glove will now be in the Strobe Mode and remain in the Strobe Mode, regardless of position, until another mode is selected or the glove is turned off.

C3: Flashlight Mode

To use one or both of your Signal Gloves as a flashlight, position your glove in the "up" position (fingers pointing up) and press the On/Off button twice (pause between presses). The glove will remain in the Flashlight Mode, regardless of position, until another mode is selected or the glove is turned off.

C4: Arrow Mode

The Arrow Mode produces continuously chasing green arrows, regardless of glove position. To enter the Arrow Mode, turn the glove to the right (horizontal) and press the On/Off button twice (pause between presses). The glove will now be in the Arrow Mode where it will remain, regardless of position, until another mode is selected or the glove is turned off.

Section D : Charging your Signal Gloves
(only use included charging devices)

D1: 12 Volt Vehicle Charging

Plug the included car charger into your 12 volt vehicle power plug. Using the included cable, plug the USB end into the vehicle charger, then plug the other end into the base of the electronics enclosure mounted to the wrist of the gloves.

D2: 120 Volt Wall Outlet Charging

Plug the accessory wall charger into a standard 110 volt wall outlet. Using the included cable, plug the USB end into the wall charger, then plug the other end into to the base of the electronics enclosure mounted to the wrist of the gloves.

D3: USB Charging

Plug the smaller connector (x2) of the included cable into the base of each glove. Plug the USB end of the cable into any powered USB port.

D4: Charging Times

Charging times will vary based on the amount of charge remaining when charging begins. Typically, an 80% charge can be achieved in 20 minutes using any charging method. Approximately two hours are required to charge from 80% to 100%.

Section E: Product Contents

- E1:** Two Safety Gloves (one pair)
- E2:** Electronics mounted to glove wrist straps
- E3:** One Wall Charger
- E4:** One Car Charger
- E5:** One USB charging cable with splitter
- E6:** One Storage Case

Section F: Product Identification

F1: Matching serial numbers for identification

- F1a:** Glove serial numbers are located on the back of the electronics cases attached to gloves.
- F1b:** Case serial number is located below.



Section G: Warranty

Signal Gloves are water resistant - malfunction may occur if electronics are fully submerged in a fluid.

Each product sold by Signal Corporation is fully warranted for one full year from the date of purchase. Warranty is limited to failure of any components or workmanship when the product is used as intended.

Any modification to the Signal Gloves product will void the warranty and could permanently damage the product. Intentional destruction or loss are not covered by the Signal Gloves Warranty.
